

Tanium certification exam retake policy

Candidates who do not pass a Tanium certification exam on the first attempt will be subject to this exam retake policy, without exception. Any candidate who does not achieve a passing score on an exam will have a seven-day wait time imposed before attempting the exam again. Wait time begins the following day.

The table below addresses eligibility regarding retakes, though a candidate can preregister for an attempt date in accordance with this policy:

First Attempt	Earliest Second Attempt (the following week)
Monday	Tuesday
Tuesday	Wednesday
Wednesday	Thursday
Thursday	Friday
Friday	Saturday
Saturday	Sunday
Sunday	Monday

ADDITIONAL RETAKES ARE AS FOLLOWS:

- 7 calendar days after the first attempt
- 14 calendar days after the second attempt
- 21 calendar days after the third attempt

Attempts beyond the 5th attempt are granted on a case-by-case basis and the candidate will need to contact certifications@tanium.com to make this request. Tanium reserves the right to deny a retake beyond the 5th attempt. Retakes are not permitted beyond the 5th attempt for one calendar year following the 5th attempt.

Retaking previously passed exams

We do not permit auditing of our exams. Candidates will not be allowed to retake an exam they have previously passed, unless related to a recertification requirement approved by Tanium.

- * Candidates who do not pass a Tanium certification exam on the second attempt must wait 14 calendar days before attempting the exam again. Waiting begins the following day.
