

# Events DC secures against ransomware with partnership from True Zero Technologies and Tanium

Events DC owns and operates 12 venues, including the Walter E. Washington Convention Center, Nationals Park, the Entertainment & Sports Arena, and the historic Carnegie Library. Their venues host a wide array of events ranging from conventions and concerts to sporting events, contributing significantly to the local community and economy.

The organization aims to provide unforgettable experiences for visitors while fostering a strong community connection. As Zach Schwartz, Chief Information Officer at Events DC, explains, "We focus on making sure if you're here visiting locally for an event at the convention center or you're out for a baseball game, you have an amazing experience". However, delivering these experiences requires not only top-tier facilities but also robust cybersecurity to protect both the organization and its visitors.

### **Ransomware Attack**

In the wake of a severe ransomware attack, Events DC faced a critical challenge: rebuilding and securing its IT infrastructure. The ransomware had locked up key systems, including the organization's financial management solution. "The ransomware attack was a dark day for Events DC," recalls Ken Ford, Chief Information Security Officer. "They took over our entire environment and encrypted everything." This incident exposed significant gaps in their cybersecurity posture, prompting a reevaluation of their systems and strategies.

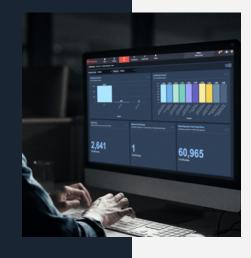
In response, Events DC sought a solution that could not only protect their IT environment but also enable them to recover swiftly from future incidents. That solution came in the form of True Zero Technologies and Tanium.

#### Why True Zero Technologies and Tanium?

## Comprehensive IT and Security Overhaul

True Zero Technologies helped Events DC deploy and manage Tanium, ensuring that the technology was fully integrated into their IT operations. According to Andrew Manos, Director of Services at True Zero, the company's approach is to view security and IT operations as one continuous workflow. "We bring our customers together on that journey from security through operations," he says.

Ken Ford, Chief Information Security Officer at Events DC, emphasized the importance of establishing secure baselines: "We deployed the security baselines first, then we looked at our patch management throughout the environment." This comprehensive approach ensured that Events DC could proactively secure its IT environment.

Ken Ford also shared how **Tanium Automate** revolutionized their device deployment process: "Using Automate, we can get a device out in less than six hours. That's re-imaging, patching, putting all of our agents, all of our security configurations." This shift allowed Events DC to focus on more critical tasks and streamline their operations.

Kristin Galemore, Director of IT Program Management at Events DC, highlights the importance of having True Zero as a partner. "Having a partner like True Zero really expedited our timeline.
